


The journey to St. Moritz offers its own unique experience, whether you opt for the UNESCO World Heritage route by train, traverse the majestic Alpine passes by car, or arrive in style and comfort via a chic and effortless private jet.

For the most convenient route in winter, we suggest arriving in Zurich by airplane. The journey from Zurich to St. Moritz is optimal, taking less than 3 hours by car or 3.5 hours when traveling by train. For all guests we offer a complimentary pick-up-service from the train station.

During the summer, the route from Milan offers a breathtaking and diverse experience, accessible solely by car. A detour to Lake Como comes highly recommended for all travelers, while navigating the winding roads of the Maloja Pass builds excitement for the Engadin high valley, perched at an elevation surpassing 1,800 meters above sea level.
