LOCATION

WHAT TO DO IN BERN AND SURROUNDINGS

SIGHTS

- Old City of Bern – UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the best examples of medieval town planning in Europe with one of the longest covered shopping malls (6 km / 3,73 mi of arcades)
- The Zytglogge (clock tower) – the artistic astronomical calendar clock created in 1530 is one of the most important and most beautiful sights of Bern
- Parliament Building – built in 1902, it is one of Bern's most important landmarks
- Einstein House – in the heart of the Old City, Kramgasse 49 was the scientist's home between 1903 and 1905. Documents and background material provide information on his work, including the famous «Theory of Relativity»
- Bear Park – Bern's emblem
- Bern Cathedral – the city's most impressive late-Gothic building

ART AND CULTURE

- Paul Klee Centre – the world's largest Paul Klee collection
- Art Museum – home to outstanding works from eight centuries
- Museum of Communication – the only museum in Switzerland dedicated exclusively to communication
- History Museum – one of Switzerland's most important art-historical collections

DISCOVER

- The river Aare – beautiful recreation area in the middle of the town: jogging, strolling and urban swimming in summer
- Emmental – mystical landscape with its typical Bernese farmhouses and dairies is just around the corner
- Schwarzenburgerland – one of the most beautiful subalpine areas in Switzerland
- Gruyères – famous for its cheese and the medieval town

FOOD & WINE

LA MAISON DU GRUYERE CHEESE DAIRY

Visit the cheese dairy and witness the production of one of the local's most favorite foods first hand. Located at the foot of the medieval town of Gruyères, you can discover all the secrets associated with the making of the legendary Swiss cheese "with holes".

MAISON CAILLER CHOCOLATE FACTORY

Try as much as you can at the Cailler chocolate factory located in the village of Broc. The experience is sensual and poetic and provides the visitor a glimpse of the world of chocolate with all of its delicious aesthetics. In case you haven't had enough, spoil yourself with a sweet chocolate treat from the pastry chef back home at your hotel, the BELLEVUE PALACE.

TERRACED VINEYARDS OF LAVAUX UNESCO

Lavaux, a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site, is one of Lake Geneva's most beautiful regions. Designed for hikers of all ages, the trail winds through the vineyards where you can taste local Swiss wines and stroll through the terraced landscape of Lavaux.



HISTORY & LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

WALK IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF A GENIUS

Walk down the Kramgasse in Bern's picturesque old town – a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site. Stop at No. 49 at the narrow building; Albert Einstein's residence in the early 19th century. This is where the Swiss citizen wrote the era's most important theory of relativity $E=mc^2$ – the foundation of modern physics. His apartment is now open to the public and you will discover how Bern inspired the mind of such a genius.

MEET AND TALK WITH LOCAL SWISS PEOPLE

Unique to Bern, you can explore the market in front of the parliament buildings where farmers sell their fresh produce. Stroll around the lively square and meet locals who will tell you fascinating stories about the city which was founded back in 1191. Did you know that the Grosser Muristalden in Bern was added to The New York Times prestigious list of favorite European city streets?
